Funding Student Breakfast and Lunch Accounts

It is the responsibility of students, guardians, and parents to ensure that their child's lunch account is adequately funded or they have daily cash payment if they intend on participating in the National School Breakfast or Lunch Program.

The Food Service Department will notify students and parents/guardians when student accounts are low or in deficit so that their account can be replenished.

The Food Service Department will make every effort to ensure that student accounts are not in deficit at the end of the school year. The District and the Food Service Management will work together to collect any money owed in student accounts at the end of a school year.

Unpaid balances at the end of the school year

The total of all outstanding student negative balances that remain unpaid at the end of the school year will be reimbursed to the food service program fund from the school district general fund.
